Originally most attempts at EAI were done using Java and J2EE, but more and more developers are convinced that the .NET Framework offers superior tools and processes. Butch Clark is one of those developers, and shows in this book how to use .NET to build an effective EAI solution. He starts by investigating several common issues that software architects and developers face when working through an integration problem. He then explains in detail one solution, which he calls the EAI Framework Project. The intent of this project is to be a learning tool, but it can certainly be used 'as-is' to provide a commercial quality, off-the-shelf solution in a fraction of the time of developing one from scratch.
