

In the middle of the turbulent sixties Hal David and Burt Bacharach teamed up to write the syrupy hit, What the World Needs Now is Love, originally sung by Jackie DeShannon on Imperial Records. Since then, the song has been performed by over 100 artists. Notable among them: Dionne Warwick, The Carpenters, Barry Manilow, Luther Vandross and Bacharach himself. It is unclear if the writers meant it to be a spiritual song (it does mention Lord) or not. But it does suggest a sacred message that is sorely needed today. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: Love your neighbor as yourself. All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments (Matthew 22:37-40). Paul penned, And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love (1Corinthians 13:13). With these truths in mind, Gaddis dissects a variety of Biblical texts (some obvious, some obscure), expounding on God's love for us, the love we should have for Him, and the love He desires that we have for one another.
